 To construct a concrete surfaced bike trail approximately 820-feet long and 8-feet wide; retaining walls, support walls, and safety handrails; two 12-foot wide barrier gates; a removable canopy under the UPRR Bridge; a flood light; replacement of a water well outfall structure; an 8-foot tall chain-link fence along North Gateway Drive; a 4-foot tall chain link fence at the bike trail entrances; and 11.6 tons of rip-rap placed along the bike trail for erosion protection.
