

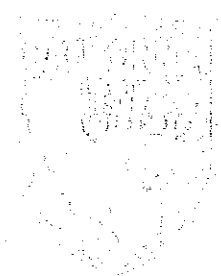

Project Title: Bacon Island Levee Rehabilitation Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0046-R3)

Project Location: Reclamation District 2028, Bacon Island Road. San Joaquin County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0046-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Reclamation District 2028, represented by David Forkel.

Project is 4.7 miles of land- and waterside levee work. Levee will be raised to HMP standards, and rip rap will be placed along the waterside slope above Mean High Water. Landside slope work consists of raising the levee crown and stabilizing the slope with fill material.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on March 12, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures X were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
