**Project Title:** Desert Knolls Wash Phase III Flood Control Project, Extension (Project) (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0136-R6)

**Project Location (San Bernardino County):** The Project is located at Desert Knolls Wash, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.535742°, Longitude -117.278972°.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0136-R6 (Agreement), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, for the project Applicant, San Bernardino Flood Control District, as represented by Arlene Chun.

The Project involves a conditional extension to the Agreement to allow the Permittee to extend the term of the Agreement from April 7, 2025 to April 7, 2030. The extension also includes modifications to the measures in the Agreement and additional measures to protect fish and wildlife resources.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the Project described above on April 21, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the Project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this Project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
