Project Title: State Route 39 Road Realignment and Bridge Replacement Project Amendment
(Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2016-0002-R5)

Project Location: The project is located along State Route 39 at Post Mile (PM) 32.1, within the Angeles National Forest, Los Angeles County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an Amendment for Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2016-0002-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. This project involves replacing the San Gabriel River Bridge # 53-2245 on State Route 39 at Post Mile 32.1 with a single span bridge. The project also includes realigning the existing road approach and departure for the new bridge and demolishing the existing structure. Riparian vegetation will be cleared for approximately 100 feet upstream and 200 feet downstream below the existing bridge. The Project will result in impacts including temporary impacts to 0.35 acre of streambed and riparian habitat (300 linear feet).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 12/13/19 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
