Project Title: West Sacramento Public Boat Dock Debris Deflector Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YOL-47733-R2)

Project Location: The project is located on the Sacramento River, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Latitude 38.582543° N, Longitude 121.508119° W (WGS 84 datum); Assessor's Parcel Number 010-422-013-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YOL-47733-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of West Sacramento.

The project is limited to removal of the existing debris deflector, repairing and then replacing the existing debris deflector to allow for the appropriate diversion of river debris and increased boater safety. The debris deflector has failed and is currently submerged below the water line of the Sacramento River.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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- 6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The mitigated negative declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
