Project Title: Camp Far West Auxiliary Spillway (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. YUB-14755-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at the Camp Far West Reservoir, approximately 6.5 miles east of Wheatland, in the County of Yuba, State of California; US Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle 'Camp Far West'; Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21; Township 14 North, Range 6 East; Latitude 39.031030°, Longitude -121.191445°; Assessor's Parcel Number 015-370-016-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number YUB-14755-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the South Sutter Water District, as represented by Brad Arnold.

The project consists of the construction of a new ogee-type auxiliary spillway structure with associated inlet channel and bridge; improving the existing spillway to accommodate the new auxiliary spillway and new road work; grading and raising the existing Blackford Road to accommodate the new auxiliary spillway and improvements to the existing spillway; and relocation of overhead utilities.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
