Project Title: Loon Lake Campground Improvement – Culvert Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-55279-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at an unnamed tributary to Loon Lake, in the County of El Dorado.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number ELD-55279-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sacramento Municipal Utility District.

- Excavate and remove the existing culvert using equipment that will be operated from the Loon Lake Access Road.
- Improve rock protection to the inlet and outlet of the culvert.
- Place the new 36-inch corrugated metal pipe culvert at grade with the existing streambed to allow for aquatic species passage.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.

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- 5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
