Project Title: Garaventa Hills Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2013-0276-R3)

Project Location (include county): Garaventa Hills (Project) is located north of Interstate-580 and east of Vasco Road in the City of Livermore, Alameda County, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2013-0276-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Jim Idleman/Lafferty Communities.

The project is limited to construction of two storm drain outfalls, installation of an Emergency Vehicle Access (EVA) bridge and temporary construction access to the bridge abutment.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on June 29, 2021, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
