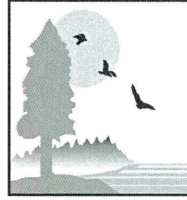

Title: Wohler Road Bridge Over the Russian River Seismic Retrofit Project

Proponent: Sonoma County

Location: 9765 Wohler Road, Forestville, Sonoma County

Description: The existing Wohler Road Bridge over the Russian River will be seismically retrofitted to prevent bridge collapse during a strong earthquake. The State Lands Commission action is an amendment to a 25-year General Lease – Public Agency Use to enlarge the lease premises from an 80-foot-wide strip to a 200-foot-wide strip for the bridge seismic retrofitting project.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on August 23, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, Sonoma County, adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring Program and approved the project on November 24, 2014. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by Sonoma County.
