Title: Wohler Road Bridge Over the Russian River Seismic Retrofit Project

Proponent: Pacific Gas and Electric

Location: Sovereign land in the Russian River, adjacent to the Wohler Road Bridge Over the Russian River Seismic Retrofit Project, near Santa Rosa, Sonoma County.

Description: Relocation an existing 12 kV electric line crossing the Russian River and continued use and maintenance of existing less-than-60 kV electric distribution overhead and submerged lines with associated fiber optic cables and related facilities. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through August 30, 2032.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, has approved the above, described project on December 17, 2020, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A  Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, Sonoma County, adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring Program and approved the project on November 24, 2014. In addition, an Addendum was prepared in August 2020 and approved on December 15, 2020. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND and Addendum as prepared for this project by Sonoma County. At this time, the Commission's offices are closed to the public due to public health and safety concerns regarding the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).
