Project Title: Dos Rios Ranch Restoration: Rubble Removal and Revegetation Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. STA-27669-R4)

Project Location: The Project is located along the Tuolumne and San Joaquin Rivers, at Dos Rios Ranch State Park, in the City of Modesto, County of Stanislaus, California; centered at latitude 37.59948 and longitude - 121.16459; Section 00, Township 4 South, Range 7 East; U.S. Geological Survey Map Westley; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 017-066-016-000, 017-066-013-000, 017-066-018-000, 017-066-019-000, and 017-066-003-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-STA-27669-R4), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, River Partners, represented by Neil Wilson.

The Project includes non-native weed removal, concrete and asphalt rubble removal, grading, and revegetation along 4,960 linear feet of streambanks on the Tuolumne and San Joaquin Rivers.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 18, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
