Project Title: Newtown Road Bridge Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. ELD-31735-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Newtown Road Bridge is located south of the community of Camino in unincorporated El Dorado County. Latitude 38.707466, Longitude -120.681808.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number ELD-31735-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, El Dorado County.

The project is limited to the removal and replacement of the existing bridge at South Fork Weber Creek. The replacement bridge will be installed on the same location using a precast arch bridge supported on spread footings. The new bridge will be approximately 192 feet long, 6 feet tall, and have an approximately 23-foot span. The replacement bridge will include three (3) wing walls and one retaining wall armored with rock slope protection.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
