Project Title: State Route 73 Southbound Mac Arthur Boulevard Off-Ramp Widening Project


Project Location (include county): The project is located on the State Route 73 Southbound Mac Arthur Boulevard off-ramp, in the County of Orange.

Project Description: This proposed project involves adding a second lane to the off-ramp and widening Bonita Creek Bridge.

The Project will result in impacts including temporary impacts to 0.062 acre of arroyo willow riparian habitat and channel bank and permanent impacts to 0.0005 acre of arroyo willow riparian habitat.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as [the lead agency / a responsible agency] approved the above-described project on January 27, 2020 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment (This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a responsible agency).
