Project Location/City/County: The project is located in Marysville, east of Highway 70 along the right (north) bank of the Yuba River at landside and waterside locations in the proximity of B, Chestnut, and Second Streets and the Southern Pacific Railroad with another location on the left (south) bank of the Yuba River near the railroad, within Section 24, T15N, R3E, MDB&M, in Yuba County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 18431, under the California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To relocate the Nicolaus-Marysville 60 kV electric transmission line and overhead distribution lines across the Yuba River and along the embankment of the right (north) bank of the Yuba River as part of Phase 2B of the USACE Marysville Ring Levee Project. Work includes installing two tubular steel transmission poles, new anchors to a transmission pole, removing seven transmission poles, removing six wood distribution poles, and permitting an existing distribution pole.
