Project Location/City/County: This project is located along the right (north) bank of the Yuba River at waterside and landside locations adjacent to Highway 20 from East 17th Street (Sta 355+00) northwest to the intersection with the Simmerly Slough Levee on the northwestern boundary of the city (Sta 1+00) in Yuba County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19650, under the California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To relocate the Smartville-Marysville 60 kV and Pease-Marysville-Harter 60kV electric transmission lines with overhead distribution lines along the waterside embankment of the right (north) bank of the Yuba River as part of Phase 3, Segment A of the USACE Marysville Ring Levee Project. Work includes installing 20 transmission poles (15 light-duty steel, 4 tubular steel, and 1 wood), installing one wood distribution pole, removing 23 transmission poles, replacing anchors on two transmission poles, and permitting an existing transmission pole.

This is to advise that the CVFPB, as the **Lead Agency**, approved the above-described project on November 7, 2022 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
