Project Location/City/County: The project is located at Sta 320+00 in the Marysville Ring Levee Project, Phase 3 Segment C, near 12th Street and Buchanan Street, near Levee Mile 1.6 of Unit 3 of the right (north) bank of the Yuba River in Yuba County.

Project Description:

Approval of Permit No. 19634, under the California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To install a two-inch conduit of fiber optic cable through the levee, from the waterside toe to the landside toe, and a new utility pole as part of the relocation of the existing aerial line. Work includes the removal of an existing pole and construction of a landside vault.
