Project Location (include county): The Robert’s Road Bridge Geotechnical Investigation, Summerwind Ranch Residential project (Project) is located at Robert’s Road and Garden Air Wash in the City of Calimesa, Riverside California; Assessor’s Parcel Number 413-200-059, Latitude 33.987291, Longitude -117.058538.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-RIV-38597-R6 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant as represented by Paul Onufer.

The Project description only includes Project activities that will occur within areas subject to Fish and Game Code §1602. The Project consists of conducting geotechnical investigations for future Robert’s Road Bridge, involving ten exploratory boring with the aid of a mounted drill rig, the holes will be filled with Native materials and bentonite.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above project described project on August 16, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
