Project Location: Palo Alto and East Palo Alto, Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties		
<p>Project Description: The City of Palo Alto, is proposing the Newell Road Bridge Replacement Project (project), which would be located at Woodland Avenue and Newell Road in the cities of Palo Alto and East Palo Alto. The project would comprise a two-lane bridge, with raised bicycle/pedestrian paths, on the existing alignment of Newell Road, and associated roadway improvements, utility relocations, retaining walls, and channel stabilization. Project improvements would extend for approximately 500 feet along Newell Road and 350 feet along Woodland Avenue.</p> <p>A portion of the proposed project activities would take place within APN 003-12-013 where Valley Water holds flood control easement. The activities occurring on Valley Water easement would include grading, creek rock slope protection installation, mulching, and concrete bag transition construction. A temporary access ramp would be constructed to provide access for channel and bridge construction work.</p>		

The lead agency, City of Palo Alto, certified the Newell Road Bridge Replacement Project Final EIR in June 2020 and approved the project, made the CEQA required findings, adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations, and adopted an MMRP per Resolution No. 9889 on June 1, 2020.


