
Project Location (Riverside County): The Project is located at up to 31 locations along Tahquitz Creek, tributary to the Whitewater River, and along the Whitewater River (Whitewater River Stormwater Channel and Coachella Valley Stormwater Channel), within the Cities of Palm Springs, Cathedral City, Palm Desert, La Quinta, Indio, Coachella, portions of the Reservations for three Native American tribes (Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians, Cabazon Band of Mission Indians and Twenty-Nine Palms Band of Mission Indians), and unincorporated areas of Riverside County, State of California. If the Cities of Rancho Mirage and Indian Wells participate in the project, then this Agreement applies also to work within those cities.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2016-0248-R6, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Jonathan Hoy of the Coachella Valley Association of Governments. The amendment updates the Project Description and Exhibits to include artificial nighttime lighting plans.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on March 11, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
