Project Location (include county): Prima Deshecha Cañada and four unnamed tributaries to Prima Deshecha Cañada, within Prima Deshecha Landfill, Zone 4, in the County of Orange.


Project Description:

CDFW is intending to execute a Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code (#1600-2016-0102-R5) to the project applicant, Orange County Waste & Recycling. The project proposes to impact 6.44 acres of streambed/lake, including 61 western sycamore trees, 5.53 acres of stream rehabilitation, and 14.68 acres of riparian buffer enhancement. Preservation of 920 existing sycamore trees will occur within the 51.06-acre Trabuco Creek Long Term Protection and Management Plan Area.
