Phone: (707) 769-5665 ext. 207**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108****State Clearinghouse Number:** 2015112053**Project Title:** Redwood Creek Trail Realignment (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0010-R3)**Project Location:** The project is located at multiple unnamed tributaries to Redwood Creek in the County of Marin within Mount Tamalpais State Park on the Redwood Creek Trail.**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0010-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Parks and Recreation, Bay Area District.

The project includes decommissioning a segment of the Redwood Creek Trail that occurs within the 100-year floodplain of Redwood Creek and realigning the trail in a less sensitive location outside of the floodplain. This includes construction of 7 free-spanning trail bridges, removal of the deck and stringers of an existing bridge, removal of a 48-inch diameter, 14-foot long culvert, and rehabilitation of the decommissioned trail segment.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 3, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
