Project Title: Lake 20 Shoulders (EA: 01-0G330) (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0055-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at post miles 5.42, 5.52, 5.54, and 5.35 of State Route (SR) 20, an unnamed tributary to Scott’s Creek, in the County of Lake, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0055-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. The Project is limited to the replacement and extension of three corrugated metal pipe culverts, the replacement, realignment, and extension of a concrete box culvert, and the associated work related to widening SR 20, performing a curve realignment, and installing turn lanes for Witter Springs Rd. All culverts will be replaced with the same material. This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
