Project Location - Specific: The ITC Project is proposed on Market St., Manchester Blvd. and Prairie Avenue

Project Location - City: Inglewood Project Location - County: Los Angeles

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The ITC Project is a 1.6-mile, three station, fully elevated electrically powered Automated Transit System (ATC) proposed to close the last-mile gap between the LA Metros K Line light rail system to major new housing, employment and activity centers in the City, including the Forum, the Los Angeles Sports and Entertainment District, which includes SoFi Stadium and the Inglewood Basketball and Entertainment Center. The ITC Project also includes a maintenance and storage facility for the ATS trains, two power distribution substations to provide power to the ATS system and surface public parking facilities at the Market St./Florence Ave. Station, the maintenance and storage facility and at 150 Market St.

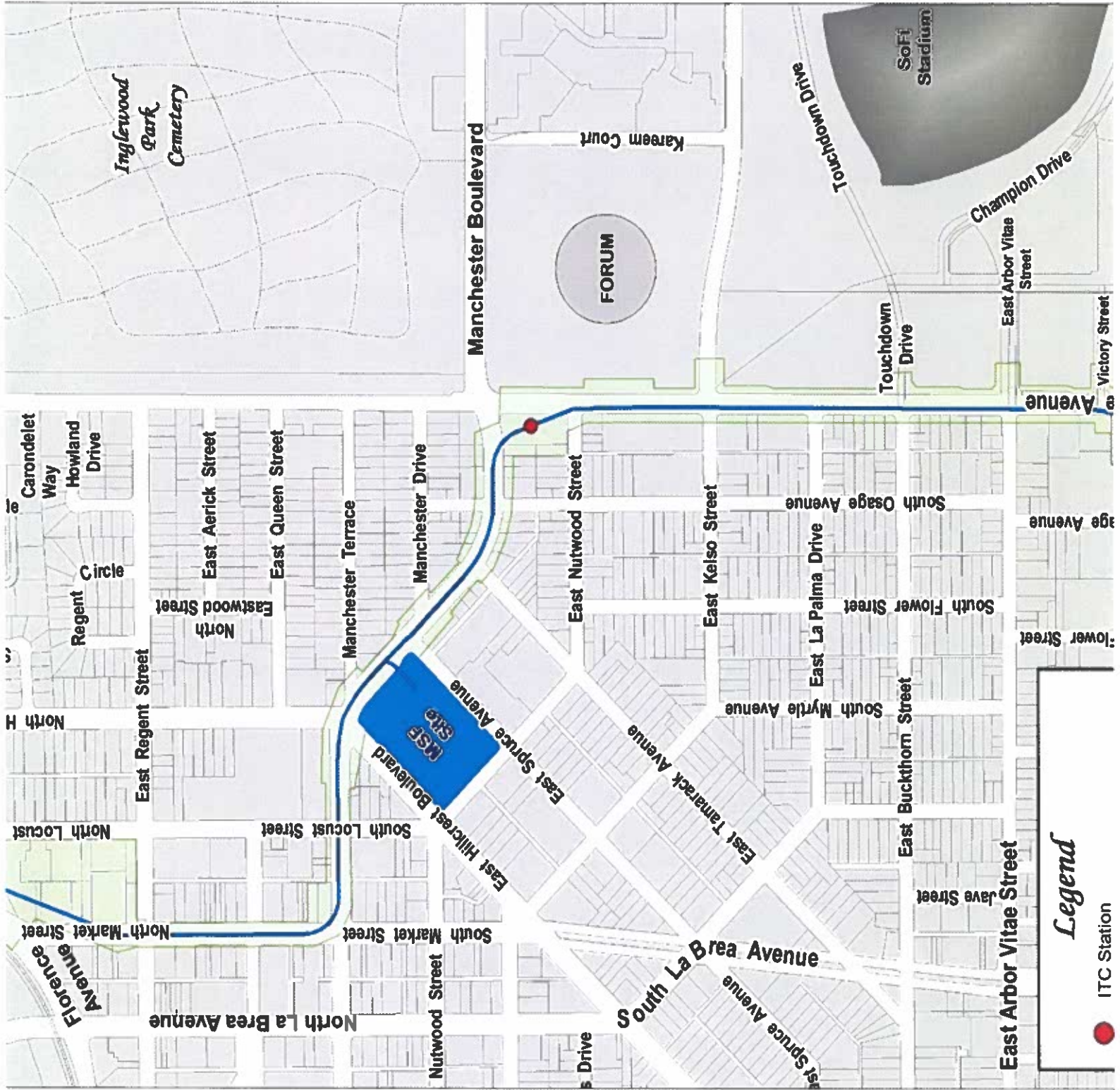
