Project Location (Contra Costa County): The project is located on West Antioch Creek, tributary to the San Joaquin River, in the City of Antioch, County of Contra Costa, State of California. Latitude 38.014028, Longitude -121.82446.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS-CCA-32699-R3, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant City of Antioch, as represented by Scott Buenting.

The project is limited to removal of approximately 3,000 cubic yards of accumulated debris, vegetation, and sediment, along 1,050 linear feet of West Antioch Creek between West 8th Street and West 4th Street. Approximately 25 yd³ of rock slope protection (RSP) will be installed at one location.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on August 23, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
