**Review of Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (SCH No. 2009091089)
MCN No. 22-143; Tentative Parcel Map (TPM 20710) No. 23-012; Design Review (DRP) No. 22-064**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Fontana has completed a Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (SCH No. 2009091089), which tiers from the City of Fontana's Final EIR for the Southwest Industrial Park (SWIP) Specific Plan Update and Annexation (SCH No. 2009091089), for the Hemlock Warehouse Development Project (Project or proposed Project) that is available for public review pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 15087. The 40.01-acre site is currently developed with light industrial uses, and used for leasing, storage, and refurbishing modular trailers. The proposed Project would redevelop the site with a new warehouse building that would have a footprint of approximately 747,000 square feet (SF), and include a first-floor office of 20,000 SF, a second-floor office mezzanine area of 20,000 SF, a warehouse area of 726,826 SF, and a pick module mezzanine area of 115,000 SF; totaling 881,826 SF. Storage of refrigerated goods may occur within 220,500 SF of the warehouse. The warehouse would have 114 loading docks located on the east and west sides of the building. Vehicular and truck access would be provided via Hemlock Avenue and Beech Avenue.

**Environmental
Determination:**

This Project has been determined have a significant effect on the environment and a Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has been prepared pursuant to Sections 15080 to 15097 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

**Location of
Property:**

The Project site is located at 11115 Hemlock Avenue, which is south of Santa Ana Avenue, north of Jurupa Avenue, east of Hemlock Avenue, and west of Beech Avenue. The Project site encompasses three parcels that total 40.01 acres, which are identified as Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 0237-131-25, 0237-131-26, and 0237-131-27.



Project Impacts: The Draft Subsequent EIR evaluates the proposed Project's potential individual- and cumulative-level environmental impacts on the following resource areas: air quality, greenhouse gas emissions, noise, transportation and traffic, and tribal cultural resources.

The Draft Subsequent EIR indicates that implementation of the proposed Project would result in significant and unavoidable impacts related to:

- **Air Quality** - Long-term operational emissions; consistency with the AQMP, and cumulative air quality impacts.
- **Greenhouse Gas Emissions** – Project emissions, consistency with regional plans, and cumulative impacts.

Consistent with the SWIP Specific Plan EIR, mitigation measures are identified in the Draft Subsequent EIR that would minimize these significant impacts but not to less than significant levels.

Public Comments: The 45-day public review period for the Draft Subsequent EIR began on October 10, 2023 and was scheduled to end on November 27, 2023. **The City has extended the public review period to end on December 11, 2023 to provide an additional 14 days for public review of the Draft Subsequent EIR. Written comments on the Draft Subsequent EIR must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 11, 2023.**
