Project Title: Athos II Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0209-R6)

Project Location: The Athos II Project (Project) is a part of the larger Athos Renewable Energy Project (AREP) which consists of Athos and Athos II located on a total of 3,224 acres and will share portions of their generation tie-in transmission lines (Gen-tie). Athos II is located on approximately 1,300 acres across 3 groups of non-contiguous parcels in Riverside County, north of I-10 and approximately 4 miles east and northeast of the town of Desert Center, California. In addition, the project consists of parcels located on BLM-administered and private land for the gen-tie lines.

Project Description: The Project includes construction, operation, and maintenance of a 200-megawatt (MW) photovoltaic (PV) solar generating facility on privately-owned land, including a 220-kV gen-tie transmission line. Permanent impacts will occur to 13.02 acres (11.18 acres of desert dry wash woodland and 1.84 acres of ephemeral wash) of Fish and Game Code Section 1602 resources.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as [the lead agency / a responsible agency] approved the above-described project on May 29, 2020 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
