**Project Description:**


Harvest Water (formerly the South County Ag Program) includes expanding Regional San's recycled water system to serve agricultural uses in south Sacramento County. The effects of Harvest Water were analyzed in an EIR that was certified in 2017. The EcoPlan and Wintertime Application Project (project)—an element of Harvest Water—includes aspects that were not known at the time the Program EIR was prepared, and this new information is the focus of the Addendum. The proposed *EcoPlan* is a cohesive plan to track and record the various ecological benefits of Harvest Water and includes specific actions to further enhance and maximize these benefits. Additionally, the Addendum evaluates wintertime uses of recycled water beyond those identified in the Program EIR, specifically the potential addition of wintertime delivery of recycled water to the Cosumnes River Preserve.

This is to advise that the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District has approved the above

1. The EcoPlan and Wintertime Application Project, as analyzed in the Addendum, will not result in any new or substantially more severe significant environmental impacts beyond those described in the certified EIR.
2. The EcoPlan and Wintertime Application Project will not meet any other conditions described in State CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 calling for the preparation of a subsequent EIR.
3. Mitigation measures from the certified EIR were made a condition of the approval of the project; no new project-specific mitigation measures are required.
4. The implementation of applicable mitigation measures from the certified EIR will be monitored and reported pursuant to the Harvest Water Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program.
5. The previous findings were reaffirmed for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
