Project Title: Lateral Pipelines and On-Farm Connections Project

Project Applicant: Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (Regional San)

Project Description:

Harvest Water (formerly the South County Ag Program) includes expanding Regional San's recycled water system to serve agricultural uses in south Sacramento County. The effects of Harvest Water were analyzed in an EIR that was certified in 2017. The Lateral Pipelines and On-Farm Connections Project, which was analyzed at a program-level in the EIR, includes the installation of new distribution mains, service connection laterals, and appurtenant facilities. Construction would begin as early as 2022 and continue for approx. 2 years. As supported by the Initial Study Checklist, Regional San has determined that the project would be within the scope of the certified EIR.

This is to advise that the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District has approved the above

1. The Lateral Pipelines and On-Farm Connections Project, as analyzed in the Initial Study Checklist, will not result in any new or substantially more severe significant environmental impacts beyond those described in the certified EIR.

4. The implementation of applicable mitigation measures from the certified EIR will be monitored and reported pursuant to the Harvest Water Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program.
5. The previous findings were reaffirmed for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
