Project Description: The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) adopted an Addendum to the previous Initial Study/Negative Declaration and approved the renewal of the Post Closure Permit (Permit) for Ducommun Aerostructures Facility (Facility), pursuant to California Health and Safety Code, Chapter 6.5, for ten years. The Facility area covers about 2.25-acre former percolation pond and 0.75-acre surface impoundment, located in Adelanto, California. The Permit outlines maintenance of the cap and cover, environmental monitoring, and maintenance of financial mechanisms to fund the post closure activities.

Closure of the Facility included removal of all free liquids, stabilization of the residual solids, placement of the stabilized wastes back in the surface impoundment, and placement of a protective cap over the surface impoundment and former percolation pond as a single unit. Closure activities commenced in November 1989 and were certified complete by DTSC on June 22, 1990. The former percolation pond and surface impoundment Post Closure Permit was issued by DTSC on January 9, 1996 and was renewed April 13, 2010. This Post Closure Permit renewal does not include any changes to the permit or physical changes, including ground disturbing activities, to the Facility.

As Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC approved the above-described project on September 2, 2022 and has made the following determinations:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of project approval.
4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
5. Findings were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
