Title: Tomales Bay Vessel Management Plan

Proponent: Multiple Applicants (see below at end of the Description for individual entities)

Location: Sovereign land in Tomales Bay, Marin County

Description: The Tomales Bay Vessel Management Plan (TBVMP) is the result of a long-term multi-agency effort to streamline and coordinate vessel management activities for the benefit of the public. The TBVMP aims to improve water quality, protect wildlife and habitat, protect public health and ensure recreational opportunities in Tomales Bay. It also implements the mandates and regulations of both Gulf of the Farallones National Marine Sanctuary and California State Lands Commission (Commission). The Commission actions are issuing a 10-year General Lease – Recreational Use for vessel mooring buoys consistent with the TBVMP to the following entities: Paul Smith (W27231) and Tom Stockl (W27228).

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 23, 2019, and made the following determinations regarding the project.
