Incidental Take Permit No. 1927-ITP-2024-004-06 (ITP) Amendment No. 1)**Project Location (include county):** City of Adelanto, San Bernardino County. The Project is located approximately 4.8 miles east of Interstate-15 at approximately 34.527936°, -117.401824°. The Project is bounded by US Highway 395 to the east and Mojave Drive to the north.**Project Description:** This proposed project involves an amendment to the previous issued WJTCA ITP. The amendment updates the Project activities (development of 35.31 acres of undeveloped land into a 280,000 square foot retail building space, parking, and associated site improvements) to include the incidental take of an additional western Joshua tree (*Yucca brevifolia*, WJT).

The Project will result in incidental take of 11 WJT which is protected under the WJTCA and the California Endangered Species Act. The WJTCA ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of western Joshua tree that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
