Project Title: State Route 1 and State Route 33 Bridges Rail Upgrade
(Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. VEN-13600-R5)


Project Location (include county): The Project is located in two locations along Willow Creek and North Matilija Creek, in the County of Ventura, State of California; Willow Creek Bridge, No. 52-0003, is located along Pacific Coast Highway (Route 1), at Post Marker (PM) 28.15; Latitude: 34.3486, Longitude: -119.4222; APN 060-0-100-010. North Fork Matilija Creek Bridge, No. 52-0173, is located along State Route (SR) 33, PM 16.13; Latitude: 34.4927, Longitude: -119.3064; APN 009-0-130-390.

Project Description: The Project is limited to upgrades and widening of two bridges located along Route 1 and SR-33. Bridge #52-0003 will be widened and the railings will be upgraded. The bridge deck will also be widened up to 1'6" on the west side (Beach Side) of the bridge by extending the bridge deck. Project activities at Bridge #52-0173 will be completed to widen the bridge and update the bridge railing. The bridge and its two existing abutments be widened 3'5" on each side. The existing wood railings and will be replaced with concrete railings. All concrete structures will be cast in place on-site. Stream water will be temporarily diverted around the project sites.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 8/8/2018 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
