The proposed Project involves the continued operation of the China Shipping Container Terminal at Berths 97-109 in the Port of Los Angeles under new or revised mitigation measures compared to those set forth in the 2008 Final EIR and reanalyzed in the 2019 Final Supplemental EIR (SCH #2003061153). After a period of litigation, the analysis will focus only on the court-ordered areas to bring the Final Supplemental EIR into compliance with CEQA, which includes impacts related to air quality, greenhouse gases, and energy use.
