Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to French Camp Slough, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude: 37.897319, Longitude: -122.220917.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-30916-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Catellus Stocken, LLC as represented by Bill Kennedy.

The project involves the installation of four (4) outfall pipes through the sidewall of an existing cement box culvert. The majority of the installation work will be conducted under the existing road, Qantas Lane.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
