Project Title: Prospect Island Tidal Habitat Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0118-R3)

Project Location: The project is located on Prospect Island, adjacent to Miner Slough and the Sacramento Deep Water Ship Channel, in Solano County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0115-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Department of Water Resources.

The Prospect Island Tidal Habitat Restoration Project will restore approximately 1,600 acres of tidal wetlands and associated habitats on Prospect Island. Project activities include levee repairs, dewatering the island, vegetation control, construction of internal restoration features, revegetation, weir construction, levee breaching, implementing avoidance and minimization measures, and post-restoration monitoring and maintenance.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 7/9/2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
