**Project Description:** The proposed permitting activity is for the abandonment of a well on an existing offshore platform near Huntington Beach. Work will involve a cement squeeze, cement placed at 4,800 feet to 4,700 feet for formation-to-formation seal, casing recovery and cement plug at 1,405–1,305 feet to seal the top hydrocarbon. The plug and abandonment of wells is contemplated once production has come to an end or if a well is deemed to be unproducibile. A notice will be submitted for the plugging and abandonment of wells, and the wells will be abandoned to California Geologic Energy Management Division (CalGEM) standards. The project activity being permitted by CalGEM is within the scope of the Upper Main Zone Cooperative Waterflood Project.

CalGEM, as the CEQA Responsible Agency, approved a permit for DCOR to abandon the well listed below, in the Huntington Beach Oil Field in Orange County.
