**Project Description:** The proposed permitting activity is to abandon one well located on an existing offshore platform (Platform Eva) located ~1.8 miles offshore near Huntington Beach, California along with 16 other active wellbores and associated equipment for oil & gas production. The proposed activity will take approximately 10 days to complete. Work will involve placing cement plugs from 3650'–1750' and 1750'–550', cutting and recovering casing at 440', and a cement plug at 550'–200' (surface plug). There will be no new seafloor disturbance associated with the permitting activity. Temporary equipment for the permitting activity will be relatively minimal as most of the needed equipment is already in place to service the existing wells. Additional temporary equipment will consist primarily of cement pumping equipment. No new permanent equipment or facilities will be constructed. All waste materials generated will be properly disposed of in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

The project activity being permitted by the California Geologic Energy Management Division (CalGEM) is within the scope of the Upper Main Zone Cooperative Waterflood Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR). The plug and abandonment of wells is contemplated on pages 184 and 211 of the Draft EIR.

CalGEM, as the CEQA Responsible Agency, approved a permit for DCOR to abandon the well listed below, in the Huntington Beach Oil Field in Orange County.
