
A record search of the NAHC Sacred Lands File failed to indicate the presence of Native American sacred places/site in the area you identified by the USGS coordinates, the Area of Potential Effect (APE). However, the absence of archaeological or cultural resources does not preclude their existence. Other data sources for Native American sacred places/sites should also be contacted. A Native American tribe of individual may be the only sources of presence of traditional cultural places or sites.

In the 1985 Appellate Court decision (170 Cal App 3rd 604), the Court held that the NAHC has jurisdiction and special expertise, as a state agency, over affected Native American resources impacted by proposed projects, including archaeological places of religious significance to Native Americans, and to Native American burial sites.

Attached is a list of Native American tribes, individuals/organization who may have knowledge of cultural resources in or near the project area. As part of the consultation process, the NAHC recommends that local governments and project developers contact the tribal government to determine if any cultural places might be impacted by the proposed action. If a response is not received in two weeks of notification the NAHC requests that a follow telephone call be made to ensure that the project information has been received.

We have been retained by Lamphier-Gregory to conduct a cultural resources study of property (350 acres) adjacent to the city of Newman, Stanislaus County, California. This project is part of an EIR for the Newman Master Plan Area #3 Master Plan, which is an overview document and does not involve archaeological field work or ground disturbing activities.

The attached map provides the project area as indicated on the Newman, CA 7.5' USGS Quadrangle.
