Project Title: Gleason Beach Roadway Realignment Project Amendment 1 (California Endangered Species Act (CESA) Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2017-040-03 (ITP) Amendment 1)

Project Location: The Gleason Beach Roadway realignment Project is located over Scotty Creek and the associated floodplain on State Route (SR) 1 between Post Mile (PM) 15.1 and 15.7 in unincorporated Sonoma County, in the State of California. Latitude 38.385331, Longitude -123.082918, in the Duncan Mills U.S.G.S. 7.5-minute quadrangle, in the Mt. Diablo meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Transportation (Permittee) proposes to realign a section of SR 1 to an inland location. The Project is limited to the replacement of the existing road alignment to a new alignment that would consist of a new 49-foot road system with 12-foot-wide lanes with 4-foot paved and 4-foot unpaved shoulders in each direction. The Project is also limited to the construction of a new 850 linear foot, clear-span bridge over Scotty Creek and its floodplain, construction of three access roads, removal of the previously existing bridge and associated box culverts, removal of previously existing fields of rock slope protection and installation of a pedestrian bridge over the old Scotty Creek bridge alignment.

This Amendment No. 1 will not increase total impacts to Covered Species habitat and will change the timeframe for Habitat Mitigation Lands due to CDFW from within 18 months of the effective date of the ITP to within 18 months of the initiation of Covered Activities, if Security is provided as per condition of approval 10 of the ITP. This will not result in the increase of impact to habitat for the Covered Species and shall not cause individual covered species the potential for take through increased habitat impacts. The Amendment referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as [the lead agency / a responsible agency] approved the above-described project on 8/5/2021 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
