Project Title: Kasson Road Quarry Excavation Qx 89-0003 (Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. 1600-2017-0358-R2)

Project Location: The project is located on the San Joaquin River, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.719508, Longitude -121.264406.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2017-0358-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Anthony Alegre.

The extension changes the expiration date of the Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement from July 13, 2023, to July 13, 2028. Up to 100,000 cubic yards of sand will be removed yearly over the course of the extended Agreement.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
