**Project Title:** Restoration of Azalea Hill – Amendment of the Mt. Tamalpais Watershed Road and Trail Management Plan (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0012-R3)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Bon Tempe Creek, an unnamed tributary to Bon Tempe Creek, and numerous unnamed tributaries to Alpine Lake, in the County of Marin. The area is called Azalea Hill and is approximately 4 miles west-southwest of the Town of Fairfax.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0012-R3) pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Marin Municipal Water District.

The project is limited to upgrading crossings, decommissioning crossings, and installing new crossings.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 17, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was /  was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
