Project Location (include county): Interstate 105 (I-105), from postmile (PM) R0.5 to PM R18.1, and on I-110, from PM R13.8 to R16.6, in Los Angeles County.

Project Description: Convert the existing High Occupancy Vehicle lane on I-105, from I-405 to Studebaker Road, to two Express Lanes in each direction with nonstandard lane and shoulder widths. The two Express Lanes would be separated from the general purpose lanes by a 2-foot-wide buffer. The project will also include a new overhead tolling system and signage, dynamic pricing on the Express Lanes, and other improvements to the I-105 Corridor including soundwalls and auxiliary lanes, in Los Angeles County.
