Description of Previous Action: The City of San Diego previously prepared a Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) No. 2982 / SCH No. 1999071104 for the El Camino Real Bridge and Road Widening Project ("Project"). The FEIR was certified by the San Diego City Council on February 14, 2017, via Resolution No. R-310960. The Project would construct roadway and bridge improvements along El Camino Real between its intersection with Via de la Valle and San Dieguito Road and along portions of Via de la Valle and San Dieguito Road to improve the structural integrity of the bridge over the San Dieguito River, alleviate problems associated with high flood events, improve pedestrian and vehicular access to nearby coastal and recreational resources, relieve traffic congestion, and improve consistency with the adopted land use plan and adopted Circulation Element in the project area.

Project Location: The project site is located along El Camino Real between Via de la Valle and San Dieguito Road and along portions of Via de la Valle and San Dieguito Road, in the northwestern portion of the City in San Diego, within the North City Future Urbanizing Area Framework Plan (NCFUA) Subarea II Community Plan Area.

Description of Subsequent Action (current project description): Since the certification of the previously approved Site Development Permit (SDP) and FEIR, the project design has been modified to the extent that it requires an amended SDP. The design modifications generally include additional construction staging and access areas, refinement to provide greater connectivity with the surrounding area and improved operational performance of the roadway, accommodations for required vehicle lane configuration and widths, reconfiguration of driveway access to the adjacent Surf Cup Sports Park property, accommodation for proper grading and drainage design, reduction of impact area from rock-slope protection and turf reinforcement mat installation, and reduction of impacts to the adjacent Fairbanks Golf Course.


