Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The applicant, Charles Joseph Associates, on behalf of Five Star Foods, proposes the demolition of an existing metal industrial building of approximately 13,000 square feet in order to construct a 58,130 square foot industrial office, manufacturing and warehouse building on 2.76 acres of land. The parcel is approximately 200 feet wide by 600 feet deep. The northern half of the project site is vacant with ruderal vegetation covering the site. Along the west property line is a wrought iron fence, a block wall along the north property line, and various trees (non heritage) and shrubs along the east property line. There is an approximate 10 foot grade difference from north to south. The project site is bound on the north by industrial office buildings. To the east are office/industrial park buildings. To the west is a recently constructed warehouse building. Across Fourth Street, is an apartment complex (Centre Club Apartments) in the City of Ontario. The zoning of the property and all properties to the north, east, and west is Industrial Park (IP) District. The project site is located approximately 300 feet west of Center Avenue, on the north side of Fourth Street, at 10234 Fourth Street; APN: 0210-371-01.
