Project Location: 14180 Road 192, on the east side of Road 192, approximately 1,600 feet south of State Route 190/ Avenue 144 / Poplar Avenue, adjacent to Poplar-Cotton Center Urban Development Boundary. (APN 302-040-018 in Section 18, Township 20S, Range 27E, MDB&M)

Project Description/Case File No: Special Use Permit PSP 14-052 will allow a Solid Waste Recycling Operation (inert debris recycling facility) on an 11.4-acre portion of a 29-acre parcel in the AE-20 (Exclusive Agricultural – 20-acre minimum) Zone. The site is not subject to Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR) Construction and Demolition and Inert Debris Transfer/Processing regulatory requirements. The activities fall under Title 14, CCR Section 18381.1. The applicant proposes hauling and stockpiling unseparated "overburden" (topsoil, rock and sand) from irrigation district and agricultural grading projects. The company also hauls and stockpiles construction debris (concrete and asphalt, with no wood or putrescible waste) from dairies and other construction projects. Approximately 7,000 tons of construction debris will be received and stock piled per year to be crushed as needed on site by a certified and licensed company with a portable crusher. Materials are stored on the site in two containment pits with a total 262,050 square foot footprint. Stored materials are delivered to properties to be used for other construction, grading or road projects. The applicant estimates that 55% of his work benefits agriculture. Also, the facility will establish a 75,000 sq. ft. area for parking (trucks, employees, and equipment), a 65,000 sq. ft. area for miscellaneous storage, and an 18,000 sq. ft. stormwater drainage basin. Equipment includes one loader truck, loading dock equipment and a water truck. Working hours are Monday through Saturday between 7AM – 5PM. The business employs the applicant, his partner son, and one employee on the site.
