**PROJECT LOCATION:** The Project will be constructed in unincorporated neighborhoods within West Modesto, Stanislaus County, California.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board is funding the Project referred to internally as West Modesto Sewer Infrastructure Project - Spencer/Marshall Neighborhood. The Project includes the installation of up to 80,000 linear feet of gravity mains and approximately 1,004 new house laterals. The State Water Board will be funding construction in the Spencer/Marshall neighborhood, which will include the installation of approximately 5,365 linear feet of sewer main, 2,800 linear feet of sewer laterals for the 114 residential parcels, and 6,000 linear feet of street overlays.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** The State Water Board has considered the Negative Declaration as prepared by the Lead Agency. The State Water Board has approved funding for the Project described above on November 27, 2024. The County of Stanislaus will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of approval of the Project.

4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was not adopted for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the Project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15091.
