Project Title: Guadalupe Oil Field Remediation and Abandonment Project (Minor Amendment No. 3, California Endangered Species Act (CESA) Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-1999-018-03 (ITP))

Project Location: The Project is located at the former Guadalupe Oil Field, 2184 West Thornberry Road in the town of Guadalupe in San Luis Obispo County.


Project Description: The Project includes remedial actions mandated in Cleanup or Abatement Order (CAO) No. 98-38, issued by the Central Coast Region of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), which covers the removal of pipeline and surface facilities no longer in use. The Project also includes emergency actions conducted in spring 1998.

The Project is expected to result in incidental take of 1,083 individuals of La Graciosa thistle (*Cirsium loncholepis*), 236 individuals of surf thistle (*Cirsium rhotophilum*), and 311 rosettes of beach spectaclepod (*Dithyrea maritima*) which are designated as threatened species under CESA. Minor Amendment No. 3 to the ITP, as amended, extends the expiration date to May 1, 2031, to complete Project activities.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as [the lead agency / a responsible agency] approved the above-described project on 2/6/2024 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
