Project Title: I-15 Logistics Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SBR-19376-R6)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within seven drainages in the City of Fontana within the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.177939 N, Longitude -117.446006 W. The project is located along Lytle Creek Road northwest of Interstate 15, west of Sierra Avenue, and on the southwestern foothills of the San Gabriel Mountains; Sections 7 and 18, Township 1 North, Range 5 West, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Devore, San Bernardino; Assessor's Parcel Number's 0239-091-13-0000, 0239-041-18-0000, 0239-071-27-0000, 0239-071-20-0000, 0239-041-17-0000, 0239-071-25-0000, 0239-071-08-0000, 0239-072-02-0000, 0239-041-15-0000, and 0239-041-02-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SBR-19376-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, I-15 Logistics LLC.

The project is limited to the development of a 1,175,720-square-foot logistics facility and the realignment of a segment of Lytle Creek Road. Activities subject to Fish and Game Code section 1602 include modifications to seven drainages (Drainage 1, 2, 3, 3-1, 3-2, 4, and 5) and culverts associated with Drainage 3, 3-2, 4, and 5; and the construction of five basins (one flood control/infiltration basin and four debris/desilting).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on January 6, 2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
