PROJECT LOCATION: Poplar Avenue and Walnut Avenue, Parcel No. 047-029-003, City of Patterson, Stanislaus County.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City will make specific changes to the original Project proposed in 2010 and some components of the original Project has been removed. The will make the following changes to the original Project:

- The City will use a biological nutrient removal oxidation ditch instead of the oxidation ditch mentioned in the original MND,
- Install a scum pump station,
- Upgrade the plant's water system,
- Upgrade the influent and effluent pump station,
- Upgrade the stormwater retention basin and pump station,
- Upgrade of dewatered solids storage area,
- Improvements of electrical, instrumentation and control system,
- Construction of permanent administration/laboratory building,
- The City removed the grinder/splitter structure and dewatering screw process from the Project.

The wastewater flow anticipated in the MND is 3.25 mgd and in the proposed change, it is 3.5 mgd. The changes to the proposed project are consistent with the original scope of the Project and the City identified no new impacts.

This is to advise that the State Water Board made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations and approved CWSRF financing on June 7, 2019 for the Project:

1. Determinations were made pursuant to the CEQA.
2. The State Water Board considered the Addendum to the MND as prepared by the City for this Project.
3. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program was adopted by the City for this Project.
4. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the City's approval of the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the City for this Project.
6. The Project will not have any adverse significant water quality effects.
