
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2017-0179-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Department of Water Resources (permittee) as represented by Mitra Emami.

This project includes the addition of Maintenance Area 20 (MA 20) levees into project area.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above amendment to the Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
